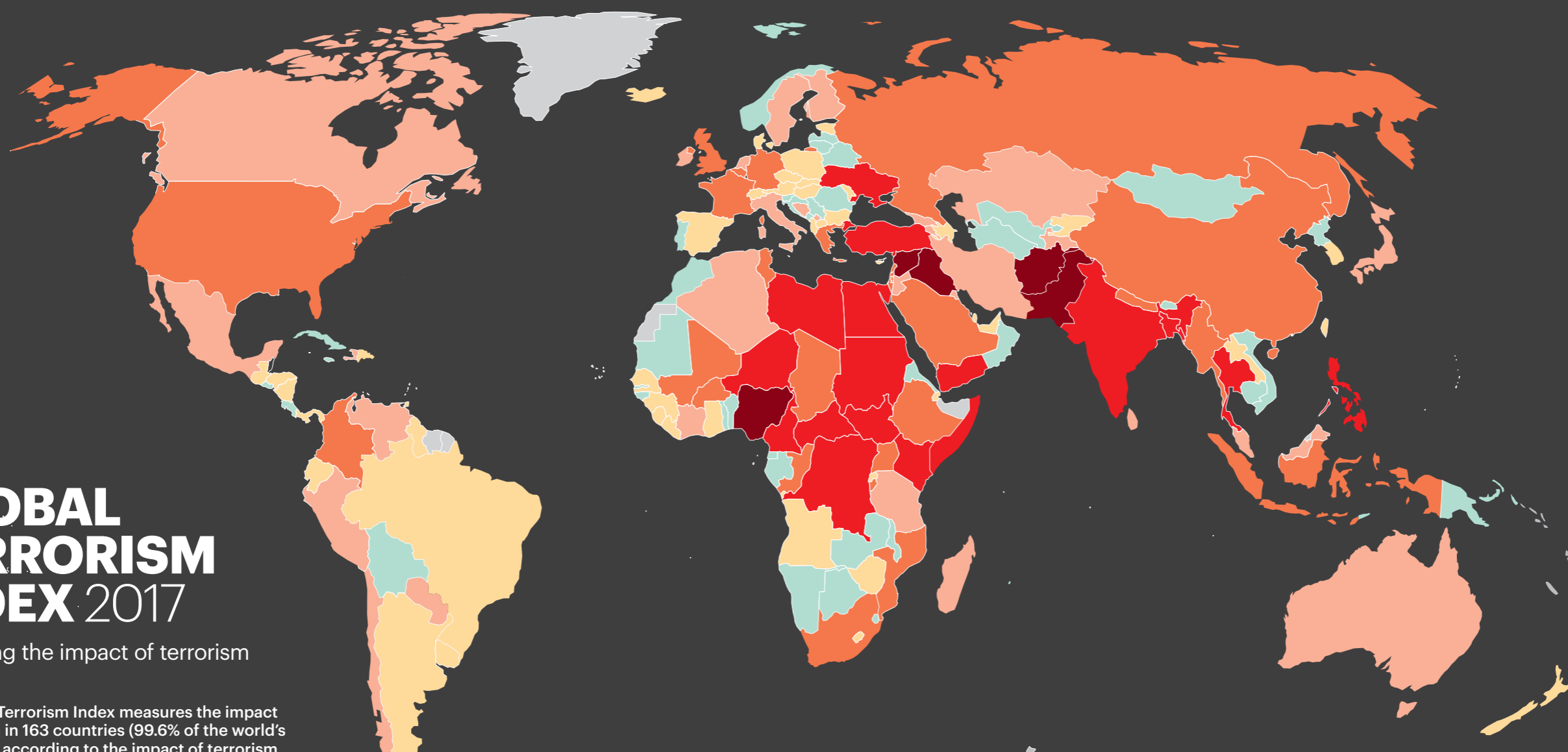


GLOBAL TERRORISM INDEX 2017

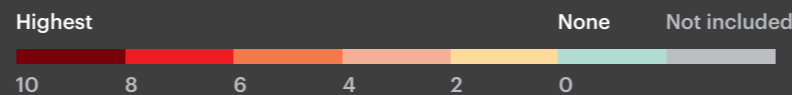
Measuring the impact of terrorism

The Global Terrorism Index measures the impact of terrorism in 163 countries (99.6% of the world's population) according to the impact of terrorism.

THE IMPACT OF TERRORISM



TOTAL DEATHS

13%

Total number of deaths is down by 13% compared to 2015 but ISIL and low-tech attacks remain a concern.

MOST IMPACTED

33%

Syria, Pakistan, Afghanistan and Nigeria, four of the five countries most impacted by terrorism, recorded 33% fewer deaths.

NIGERIA

80%

Terrorism deaths attributed to Boko Haram in Nigeria fell by 80% as the group faced military pressure.

POLITICAL TERROR

99%

Since 2000, 99% of deaths have occurred in countries either in conflict or with high levels of political terror.

OECD COUNTRIES

265

In 2016, OECD countries experienced 265 deaths, the highest number since 2001, but this trend appears to be declining.

ISIL

50%

ISIL killed 50% more people in 2016, making it their deadliest year with over 9,000 deaths, primarily in Iraq.
